***Contest Rules: Please read carefully. Applications without this information will be disqualified.***

**-A photocopy of photo id submitted with application, must indicate date of birth (passport, driver's license, etc.)**

-Submit proof of enrollment **if already enrolled** in a University or College-No applications from previous years will be considered. Applicant must submit current application.

-Applicants must consider themselves keepers of only the Seventh-day Biblical Sabbath, regardless of Sabbath-keeping denomination (no one who observes Sunday or both Sabbath and Sunday will be considered).

-All applications must be hand-written in English by the student personally AND a typed copy submitted of the essay questions. Essays must also be handwritten.

--All attachments (letters of recommendation, typed essays, etc.) must be submitted **on 8½" x 11" or A4 paper.**

Judging will be different this year. 100 possible points will be awarded for the following things: goals; letters of recommendation; academics (GPA, extracurricular activities, etc.); financial need; and essays.

-You need TWO recommendation letters: Attach recommendations *from your high school/college counselor or teacher and your church elder or pastor.*

-If you do not have a church pastor, an elder or any leader in your religious affiliation will suffice. The purpose of this letter is to help us know more about your leadership skills, spiritual outlook, academic record/achievement, and your other characteristics, as well as your conviction to the Seventh Day Sabbath.

-If you are home schooled: You can obtain a recommendation letter from any leader in your community that knows you in lieu of the high school counselor/teacher letter. Other potential sources are your extracurricular activity/organizational leaders (like sport instructors, music teachers, dance teachers, 4-H leaders, etc). Parents may NOT write recommendation letters for their children.

-There will only be one contest this year. International applicants are welcome to apply but must follow the same rules as American applicants. International applicants, please pay attention to the due date and mail your applications four weeks before time to make sure they arrive on time.
